







# SPANISH COURSES AND CULTURAL ACTIVITIES FOR SECONDARY SCHOOL GROUPS IN GRANADA

Secondary school groups have participated in these programmes for many years. On request we'll prepare a tailor-made programme for you based on a 1 or 2 weeks stay. Courses start every Monday throughout the year.

## **Spanish course**

#### Content

Our courses have a very communicative approach, however, the group may determine the content of the programme (grammar or conversation, DELE exam preparation, Business Spanish, etc.).

#### **Schedule**

Monday to Friday with 4 lessons of 45 minutes in the morning. If there is a public holiday, the lessons will be rescheduled or we invoice only 4 course days.

## **Level groups**

From 10 to 15 students in closed groups.

#### **Level test**

The school sends us the level groups together with a description of the different levels before the programme starts.

#### **Certificates**

A certificate of attendance will be given at the end of the course to each student (in digital form and in paper).





## **Accommodation**

We will place the minors in host families (double or triple rooms), including full board. Groups with older students can also choose half board. Depending on their daily activities, the families may provide a sack lunch instead of a meal. Single rooms are also available. All our host families have been with us for many years. They live in the city center and within walking distance to the school. Students do not need to take public transport.

The school will provide us with a list of students, including personal data, passport number, date of birth, special diets, allergies and the allocation of the students in the host families.

We will forward the list with the host families 15 days before arrival by email.

The accompanying teachers will determine the curfew at night. This will be supervised by the host families.

## **Cultural programme**

We will organize a personalized cultural programme based on the wishes of the group. All activities will be accompanied by professional guides. The explanations will be in Spanish, since cultural activities are meant to complement the Spanish lessons. All expenses (transportation, guides, entrance fees, insurances) are included in the final price.

## **Transfer**

We will organize the transfers from the airports in Granada, Malaga, Seville or Madrid. Our driver will pick you up at the airport and takes you to the meeting point in Granada. A representative of the school will welcome the group and introduce the students to their host families. On the departure day, the students will be accompanied by the host families to the meeting point in order to take the bus to the airport.

#### Other services

- 24 hrs. emergency phone.
- A person from the school will be responsible for making sure everything goes smoothly.

## **Accompanying teachers**

Tutors come along for free (one free place for every 15 students). The free place includes:

- Hotel\*\*\* accommodation (single room/breakfast).
- Cultural activities.
- Transfer.

# **Budget**

The cost proposal is calculated based on a minimum number of students. To prepare the cost proposal, we need the following information:

- Transfer; arrival and departure airport.
- Number of weeks (arrival and departure day)
- Number of students.
- Number of accompanying teachers.
- Number of classes per week.
- Accommodation type (host family/double rooms/half or full board).
- Type of cultural activities.

Once the school has accepted the cost proposal we need the following information:

- Full address of the college for billing.
- Information about teachers and students (personal data, special diets, allergies).
- Level groups (provided by the tutors).
- Allocation of students in host families.
- Curfew at night.
- Flight details (airline, flight number, arrival/departure airport).
- Mobile phone numbers of the tutors.

## **Payments**

We do not charge a reservation fee. The total amount of the stay must be paid at least 2 weeks before the course starts by wire transfer.

## **Cancellation**

Terms of cancellation are determined in a contract between the school and Escuela Montalbán.
