II. COURSE PROGRAMME

TEACHING

Escuela Montalbán has a highly qualified, enthusiastic and professional team of teachers, whose objective is to help you learn Spanish and discover the Spanish culture. Accordingly, we take a communicative approach to learning, with exceptionally qualified and motivated teachers. We employ only native speakers with an university degree in Spanish studies and native speakers. The objective of teachers is to ensure that students are able to communicate effectively in Spanish. And for this to happen, they pay attention to some very important aspects: firstly, a well-prepared class with clear objectives and with special emphasis on the different language skills.

Secondly, they take into account the emotional dimension of learning and positive feedback, which allows the student to free the creative potential. And, thirdly, they take a student-oriented approach, recognizing that each person has a different way of learning. María Rodríguez Martínez as the head of studies is in charge of level testing and level groups. She is the contact persons, if students have to change levels.

We offer the following 6 different course levels which correspond to those set out in the new «European Framework for Language Learning, Teaching and Evaluation». Each level corresponds to a 4 week Spanish course

OUR SPANISH LEVELS

A1 LEVEL (Beginner)

The student will be able to:

- understand and use familiar everyday expressions and very basic phrases in order to satisfy simple daily needs.
- introduce him or herself and others, and both ask and answer questions concerning where s/he lives, who s/he knows and the things s/he has.
- interact in a simple way, provided the other person speaks slowly and clearly and is prepared to help.

A2 LEVEL (Elementary)

The student will be able to:

- understand sentences and frequently-used expressions relating to areas of most immediate relevance, for example, very basic personal and family information, shopping, local geography and employment.
- communicate routine tasks, requiring the simple and direct exchange of information about familiar matter.
- in simple terms, describe aspects of background, environment and matters of immediate need.

B1 LEVEL (Intermediate)

The student will be able to:

- understand the main points related to familiar matters regularly encountered in work, school and leisure.
- deal with most situations likely to arise whilst travelling in an area where the Spanish language is spoken.
- produce simple connected texts on topics which are familiar or of personal interest.
- describe experiences and events, dreams, hopes and ambitions, and briefly give reasons and explanations for opinions and plans.

B2 LEVEL (Upper Intermediate)

The student will be able to:

- understand the main ideas of complex texts on both concrete and abstract topics, including technical discussions in fields of specialisation.
- interact with a degree of fluency and spontaneity that makes regular communication with native speakers quite comfortable without being a strain for either party.
- produce clear, detailed text on a wide range of subjects and explain a viewpoint on a topical issue, giving the advantages and disadvantages of various options.

C1 LEVEL (Advanced)

The student will be able to:

- understand a wide range of demanding, longer texts and recognize implicit meaning
- express him or herself fluently and spontaneously without much obvious searching for expressions.
- use language flexibly and effectively for social, academic and professional purposes.
- produce clear, well-structured and detailed text on complex subjects, showing controlled use of grammar and phraseology.

C2 LEVEL (Proficiency)

The student will be able to:

- understand with ease virtually everything heard or read.
- summarize information from different spoken and written sources, reconstructing arguments and accounts in a coherent presentation.
- express him or herself spontaneously, very fluently and precisely, differentiating finer shades of meaning even in more complex situations.

The school will send a written level test and a self-assessment oral test together with the course documents. On the first course day all students start immediately with the class.

Your learning journey: Cumulative Progression

The Intensive 20 Spanish course forms the foundation of our academic programme. All other programmes (Intensive 30, private lessons, exam preparation, etc.) are built upon this course and are offered as supplementary options to accelerate or personalise your learning.

Our Spanish programme follows a cumulative structure, meaning that each level builds on the previous one. The number of lessons shown for each level includes the lessons required to complete that level plus all previous levels. In other words, the total reflects the full learning journey from beginner to your target level.

For example: To reach the Spanish level B1 with our **Intensive 20 course**, the total increases to 480 lessons (*24 course weeks*). This progression ensures that students develop their language skills step by step, with each level reinforcing and expanding what has already been learned.

- **Level A1 (A1.1 + A1.2):** 80 lessons (4 weeks)
- **Level A2 (A2.1 + A2.2):** 160 additional lessons (8 weeks) → 240 lessons in total (12 weeks)
- **Level B1 (B1.1 + B1.2):** 240 additional lessons (12 weeks) → 480 lessons in total (24 weeks)
- **Level B2 (B2.1 + B2.2):** 320 additional lessons (16 weeks) → 800 lessons in total (40 weeks)
- **Level C1 (C1.1 + C1.2):** 400 additional lessons (20 weeks) → 1200 lessons in total (60 weeks)
- **Level C2 (C2.1 + C2.2):** 480 additional lessons (24 weeks) → 1680 lessons in total (84 weeks)

The time indicated for moving up a level is approximate and may vary depending on each student's profile and learning pace.

COURSE DATES AND PRICES 2026

Starting dates for all courses and for all levels: Every Monday.

Holidays without classes:

06 January, 03 April, 1 May, 04 June, 12 October, 02 November, 07 December. If a public holiday falls on a Monday, the courses start on Tuesdays. These classes are not recoverable; except in the case of 1 week courses and private courses.

Last course day: Friday, 18.12.2026.

SCHEDULES

You have several teachers for all the lessons and you normally stay in the same classroom all morning. Spanish classes are held from Monday to Friday between 09.00 h and 18.00 h. There are 4, 5 or 6 lessons of language tuition per day, each lasting 45 minutes.

Max. number of students per level group: 10 (*average 2 to 6*)

IV. ACCOMODATION & TRANSFER

Escuela Montalbán offers a professional accommodation service. The accommodation you choose will play an important part in your experience and we are here to guide and help you to choose the best option. There are several accommodation options to choose from, all of which are carefully selected, continuously checked, and located close to the school.

- Accommodation with use of kitchen facilities in school flats with students from the school.
- Homestay with breakfast, half board or full board.
- Accommodation at a teacher's home.

We charge an accommodation placement fee of 30 €, but we do not charge a deposit. Students pay for any damages caused to furniture, dishes, bed linen etc. Students receive accommodation details together with the course documents by email: accommodation address, city map and contact phone numbers. We place great effort in finding special accommodation that will make your stay in Spain worthwhile and memorable. We hope that the care that your hosts place in their work will help you to understand a lot about Spanish culture and will help you to experience it firsthand. If, however, you have questions or concerns regarding your accommodation, please do not hesitate to contact our office. If there is any problem with the housing, please communicate it to the school office in order to find a quick solution. Please keep in mind as well, that it takes time to adapt to the household and that you should try to be flexible. In the case of problems, students can change their accommodation without any additional costs.

Arrival day and time:

Students check in on Sundays before the course begins and check out at 12.00 h on Saturdays, at the end of their course. Bookings for extra nights are possible. It is necessary that students inform us as soon as possible about their approximate arrival time. If the student does not communicate the arrival time and due to this cause he does not find the owner, there will not be refunds if the student takes a room in a hotel, hostel or other accommodation. In case of home stay the hosts will wait for the students at the flat. On arrival they will receive the keys. In case of school apartments a responsible from the school will wait for students at the flat.

General rules and services:

- In the case of home stay and school apartments a cleaning service is provided at least once a week.
- All types of accommodation include a weekly laundry service or the use of washing machines; bed linen is provided, but not towels.
- Services are also included (electricity, water, gas).
- WIFI is available in most of our accommodations.
- Double rooms are reserved for 2 people travelling together.
- In case that students book half board, this consists in breakfast and lunch. Lunch time in Spain is around 14.30 h. If you should not be able to take the meals for any reasons, please tell the hosts in advance, so they don't have any unnecessary work. In case of private accommodations it is not allowed to use the kitchen.
- Any changes (meals, room types etc.) have to be communicated to the school office first. The school will then communicate the changes to the hosts.

Special rules for school flats:

- Please turn off the lights and heating when not in use. Electricity is very expensive.
- Please make sure that you do not waste water as Granada suffers from water problems.
- Always lock your room when you leave the flat.
- Please throw the garbage in the containers outside (except Sundays) after 20.00 h. You will find green containers at the entrance of the building.
- Recycling: think of the environment and use the special containers for plastic (yellow), glass (green) and paper (blue) near the flat.
- It is forbidden to smoke inside the flat.
- Please respect the public spaces.
- The living room and kitchen should be cleaned and kept in order.
- You are not allowed to have a party in the flat. Please think of the neighbours and do not make any noise after 23.00 h.
- Note that you are not allowed to have anyone stay overnight in the flat without the school's permission. Guests pay the nights spent in the flat; the cost per person and per night is of 30 € in a single room and 25 € in a double room.
- If you want to continue in the flat without doing a course, contact us.
- You must pay for any damages caused to furniture, dishes, bed linen etc.
- Students must check out before 12.00 h on Saturdays.
- The school will clean the flat on a regular basis, and usually on Saturday mornings.
- Please facilitate the access to the kitchen and the bathrooms on those days, and wait until they have been cleaned to use them.
- Please make sure you gather and put away any personal valuables to avoid accidental damage.

HEALTH CARE

We recommend that you make sure you are covered for healthcare at all times in Spain. If you are a European Union citizen, you are automatically entitled to free basic health care in Spain due to reciprocal agreements among EU countries. Since the 1st June 2004, European citizens who are travelling within the European Economic Area are given a European Health Insurance Card, which simplifies the procedure when receiving medical assistance during their stay in a Member State. The European Health Insurance Card replaces forms E111 and E111B, E110, E128 and E119.

EMERGENCIAS



Under Spanish law, any health organization, public or private, is required to treat patients in an emergency situation regardless of their insurance status. So, in case of an emergency, don't worry about insurance issues and just head directly to the public hospital PTS (URGENCIAS).

Medical consultations in town do exist, but you need to make an appointment first and pay (with cash or credit card) after the treatment. Most doctors work in hospitals rather than private practice.

To register in the emergency entrance at PTS hospital you need your passport and your European identification card from your insurance company of your home country. When you are registered by the staff in the lobby and you have told them what your problem is, you will be asked to take a seat in the waiting room until they call you. Be advised that you may have a long wait. Afterwards you will go to the examination room for treatment and help. Usually, you will get medication that you can pick up in one of the pharmacies in town. Non-European citizens normally receive an invoice. In that case you pay the treatment and at home you ask your insurance company for the refund. Some of the doctors speak English, so don't worry!

Use the general emergency number 112 if you need an ambulance.

PHARMACIES



For minor ailments, many people go to their local pharmacy (farmacia), these are easily recognisable by the green flashing cross displayed outside or in the window. Farmacias take turns to provide an out-of-hours service (at night and for holidays) as the farmacia de guardia. You will be able to find out which one is open by looking in a local paper or in the window of any pharmacy where they usually display a list.

Pharmacists in Spain are more highly-trained than in some countries and will provide treatment advice for many common illnesses and ailments, but they are not a substitute for going to a doctor if there is something really wrong with you. Spain is quite unrestrictive when it comes to the distribution of medications that are strictly prescription drugs in other countries (such as antibiotics), so these are commonly available over-the-counter. Medicines tend to cost significantly less than in other countries due to state imposed price restrictions.

SECURITY

Spain's crime rate is among the lowest in Europe. As in other countries, major cities have the highest crime rates and Alicante, Barcelona, Madrid, Malaga, Seville and Valencia are among the worst. Many cities are notorious for 'petty' crime such as handbag snatching, pickpockets and thefts of and from vehicles. Stealing from cars, particularly those with foreign registrations, is endemic throughout Spain. You should never leave anything on display in your car, including your stereo system, which should be removed when parking in cities and towns (in some areas it will be gone within 15 minutes). Even storing valuables in your boot (trunk) isn't advisable, as thieves may force them open and steal the contents. In cities, it's advisable to park in 'guarded' car parks, although they take no responsibility for a car's contents.

The most common crime in Spain is theft, which embraces a multitude of forms. One of the most common is the ride-by bag snatcher on a motorbike or moped. Known as the 'pull' (tirón), it involves grabbing a hand or shoulder bag (or a camera) and riding off with it, sometimes with the owner still attached (occasionally causing serious injuries). It's advisable to carry bags on the inside of the pavement and to wear shoulder bags diagonally across your chest, although it's better not to carry a bag at all (the strap can be cut) and wear a wrist pouch or money belt. You should also be wary of bag-snatchers in airport and other car parks, and never wear valuable jewellery and watches in high-risk areas. Motorcycle thieves also smash car windows at traffic lights to steal articles left on seats, so stow bags on the floor or behind seats.

Tourists and travellers are the targets of some of Spain's most enterprising criminals, including highwaymen, who pose as accident or breakdown victims and rob motorists who stop to help them. Don't leave cash or valuables unattended when swimming or leave your bags, cameras or jackets lying around on chairs in café or bars (always keep an eye on your belongings in public places). Beware of gangs of child thieves in cities such as Madrid and Barcelona, pickpockets and over-friendly strangers. Always remain vigilant in tourist haunts, queues and anywhere there are large crowds, and never tempt fate with an exposed wallet or purse or by flashing your money around. One of the most effective methods of protecting your passport, Money and credit cards is with an old-fashioned money belt.

In Granada take care in the following areas: Granada Busstation, Albaicín (especially Mirador de San Nicolás), Internet cafés around Plaza Nueva, squares where tourists hang around such as Plaza Bib-Ramblas. Women always should take a taxi home, when it's far after midnight.
